Online sample of 1079 likely voters fielded over web panels and via text-to-web from May 16, 2026 to May 19, 2026 and weighted by gender, race, 2024 Presidential Vote, education, age, and survey mode. Respondents were also weighted by whether they passed attention checks. The margin of error is 3.9%.
